WARRANTY INFORMATION

Limited Structural Integrity Warranty

Teckton warrants its products, in their original manufactured condition, to be free from defects in lamination, assembly, milling and dimension. Teckton products will remain free from these structural defects for life provided they are installed in accordance with our installation guidelines and are maintained in a controlled environment as outlined in our installation guidelines. This warranty is extended to the original purchaser of the goods and is not transferable.

Commercial Application Warranty

Teckton products installed in light commercial applications, will be afforded a 3 or 5 year warranty as stated in the "Finish Warranties" section of this document at the time of sale, on both structural integrity and finish provided the floor is cared for in a proper way and is not subject to water leaks, floods or maintenance procedures that utilize wet or damp mopping procedures. Water leaks, floods and improper maintenance will void all commercial warranties. Commercial applications must also be regulated to ensure acceptable jobsite conditions of 35-55% RH and 68-72 degrees from date of installation onward. At its discretion, Teckton will require a Fidbox® data logging system to be placed on certain projects and our warranty reparations will be dependent on the return of the data from the Fidbox® logging system.

Light commercial is defined as any installation not in a dwelling where the flooring will be subject to similar daily foot traffic as in a home. Light commercial installations will not be subject to heavy commercial objects (like retail racks) or machinery (like auto-scrubbers) placed on or dragged across the floor. Examples of light commercial applications are doctor's offices, business conference rooms, etc. Heavy traffic locations such as restaurants are not considered light commercial applications and would not be covered by this warranty. The same exclusions pertaining to the residential warranty apply to the light commercial warranty.

Radiant Heat Applications

This warranty does not cover radiant heat applications. For information about our warranty as it relates to radiant heat applications please refer to our separate warranty document for radiant heat applications available on our web site.

Seasonal Changes

Wood is a hygroscopic material and will expand and contract with changing moisture conditions (seasons). Some minor separation between boards might occur during seasonal change. This is not considered a defect and is not covered by this warranty.

Warranty Exclusions

Teckton warranties do not cover structural damage that results from products installed or maintained in environments with relative humidity outside the range of 35-55%. Extreme moisture conditions, specifically dry environments, can damage the structural integrity of the flooring. Carefully read our Installation Guidelines for a complete list of Acceptable Jobsite Conditions.

Teckton warranties do not cover indentations, scratches, defects or damages caused by the failure to follow all of the manufacturer's installation procedures. Responsibility for inspection and approval of wood floors falls to the consumer and installer prior to permanent installation. The installer is the final inspector of the product. Teckton is not responsible for labor costs associated with the repair or replacement of visually defective planks after the floor is installed. In addition, prior to installation the installer should make certain that the subfloor is properly inspected for flatness and moisture conditions according to the NWFA guidelines. Teckton guidelines should also be consulted for installation over radiant heat floors.

Teckton warranties do not cover normal wear and tear, indentations, scratches, defects or damages caused by improper maintenance, insufficient protection, misuse or improper alterations of the original manufactured product.

Teckton warranties do not cover indentations, scratches, defects or damages caused by negligence or abuse including, but not limited to water, insects, pets, spiked or damaged heel shoes, vacuums, furniture, appliances, casters, falling or dropped objects or construction traffic, or failure to take proper precautions to protect furniture legs and feet with protective pads and properly functioning casters or improper protection during the construction process when moving heavy objects, or during times of heavy traffic.

Teckton warranties do not cover defects and damages caused by man made or natural disasters including but not limited to, leaking or broken plumbing, fire, flood, earthquake or standing water during or after construction.

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Teckton warranties do not cover splits, checks or cracks in flooring discovered after installation.

No warranties apply to any product or products designated as off-goods or goods sold "as is".

Teckton limited structural integrity warranty does not apply to product subjected to environments that fall outside of 35% - 55% interior relative humidity.

Teckton warranties do not cover squeaking, creaking or popping in flooring.

The following items are not covered by warranty:

- · Flooring installed in a method other than provided for in Teckton installation instructions.
- Damage caused by normal wear and tear, negligence, accidents, misuse or abuse.
- Damage caused by vacuum cleaners.
- Damage caused by appliances, furniture and casters.
- · Damage caused by cutting from sharp objects.
- Damage caused by flooding, fire, and other natural disasters and acts of God.
- · Color, shade, or texture variations between samples or replacement flooring and the actual material.
- Changes in color due to exposure to sunlight and age.
- Deficiencies related to subfloor/floor assemblies, subfloor preparation materials, and fasteners including, but not limited to, uneven subfloor surfaces, floor deflection or voids in the subfloor.
- Noises, squeaks, etc.
- · Naturally occurring wood characteristics such as variations in grain, color, mineral streaks and knots.
- Natural expansion and contraction resulting in damage or separation between boards or damage caused by low or excessive humidity.
- Sheer, delamination, or other structural damage due to relative humidity levels below 35%.
- Products designated "off-goods" Such products are sold "AS IS."
- · Commercial installations of residential products.
- · Construction or installation-related damage.
- Floor damage, finish damage, or adhesive breakdown caused by subfloor moisture or water damage, including but not limited to, broken or leaking water pipes, flooding, wet-mopping spills or weather conditions.
- · Any failure or damage due to adhesive, adhesive systems, fasteners, or fastening systems.

IMPORTANT

YOU AND YOUR INSTALLER ARE RESPONSIBLE TO INSPECT FLOORING PRIOR TO INSTALLATION. WE ACCEPT NO RESPONSIBILITY FOR LIABILITIES, CLAIMS OR EXPENSES, INCLUDING LABOR COSTS, WHERE FLOORING WITH VISIBLE OR MEASURABLE DEFECTS HAS BEEN INSTALLED.

How to Make a Claim

In the unlikely event that any portion of your floor should fail, with respect to any of the provision of this warranty, Teckton, at its sole discretion, to the original purchaser, will repair, refinish or replace such portion with the same product or another product of equal value at no cost to you. This provision does not include labor costs, relocation or living expenses, removal or installation of new flooring or the removal or replacement of cabinets, furniture and other fixtures.

To file a claim, first contact Teckton for instructions. Teckton will request your contact information, the date of purchase, name of retailer and installer and the sales invoice or receipt. Claims must also be filed within the warranty coverage period and information verifying the date of purchase will be requested. Teckton reserves the right to have a designated representative inspect the floors and remove samples for technical analysis.

This writing is the complete and exclusive statement of the warranty, and is in lieu of all other express and/or statutory warranties. Teckton assumes no liability for incidental or consequential damages. However, some states do not allow this exclusion and may not apply in all cases. This warranty gives you specific legal rights that may vary from state to state.

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
